Dates: Tuesday, May 30th - Thursday, June 29th

Fees: Tuition will be funded by a grant this year!



*You will have your choice of completing your Summer School course(s) at home or in-person at your campus. *There will be teachers and paras available to provide support in classes on each campus. Students who choose to attend in person will be provided a free breakfast. Lunch will be available at the normal school lunch program pricing. Transportation will be provided with grant funding for all students within school bussing boundaries (transit-style stops).

- * All students will have access to their online class(es) 24/7.
- * All coursework taken online or at the BUHSD Learning Center, EFHS, or YHS must be completed by 12 pm (noon) on June 29th. Students attending in-person at these sites will be released to go home at noon. Students attending in-person at BUHS must be completed by 1 pm on June 29th and will be released to go home at that time.

Classes Offered

Various classes are offered during Summer School. Refer to the attached list on page 4 for complete course listings. You may begin by enrolling in one full (1.0) credit course or two half (0.5) credit courses. If you are a senior only needing one-half (.5) credit to graduate, you are only required to take what is needed to earn a diploma. If you complete your class(es) early, you may enroll in another course if time allows. A maximum of 2.0 credits can be earned in Summer School. Contact the Summer School Counselor if you wish to discuss enrolling in an extra course once completing your initial one(s).

Coursework will be offered between two different programs: Edgenuity and Schools PLP. Courses taken on Edgenuity will be given a letter grade. This platform will be used for Acceleration courses to get ahead, Repeating a class for a better grade, or Credit Deficiency courses. Schools PLP classes will be graded as Pass/Fail. This program will be used for Credit Recovery (classes you have previously taken but failed) and students with IEPs/EL services if a modified curriculum is needed.

Policies, Procedures, and Expectations

BUHSD Summer School Policies, Procedures, and Expectations are located on page 3 of this packet. By submitting the Google Form, you acknowledge you have read and understand the information. If the in-person option is chosen, students will be expected to attend every day until the course(s) are completed.

School Rules and Expectations

All school/district rules and expectations from the regular school year will be enforced during Summer School. These are listed in the Parent-Student Handbook, which can be found on the district's website (www.buhsd.org) under the families dropdown link. If an in-person student receives 3 minor discipline referrals or 1 major referral, they will be withdrawn from Summer School or sent home to complete their course(s) for the remainder of Summer School.

Registration Process

Complete the appropriate Google Form posted online using the URL provided on the last page of this application or by clicking on the Summer School logo on the district website (www.buhsd.org).

The Google Form must be completed no later than <u>3 pm on Friday, May 19th</u> if you wish to start classes on Tuesday, May 30th. Applications will be accepted up until 12 pm (noon) on Thursday, May 25th, but the start of the course will be delayed 2 days. Late enrollments will start classes on Thursday, June 1.

Policies, Procedures, and Expectations

1. Grades:

- Students will receive a letter grade for successful completion of classes on Edgenuity. The grade(s) will figure into a student's GPA and count toward class ranking. This platform will be used for Acceleration courses to get ahead, Repeating a class for a better grade, or Credit Deficiency courses.
- Students will receive a Pass/Fail for successful completion of classes on Schools PLP. These will be classes taken for Credit Recovery (if you have previously taken a course and failed it). The grade(s) will not be figured into a student's GPA.
- Final grades will be provided by teachers/course facilitators upon successful completion of the course(s). All courses must be completed by 12 pm (noon) on June 29th, except for BUHS with a 1 pm deadline on June 29th.
- Any course(s) a student earns credit for will be posted to the student's official transcript with the letter grade or (P) for pass.
- Grades will be e-mailed home at the conclusion of Summer School.
- 2. <u>Course Completions</u>: If you complete your class(es) early, contact Ms. Fox, (<u>sfox@buhsd.org</u>) the Summer School Director, for notification. If you would like to start another course, contact Mrs. Lees (mlees@buhsd.org).
- 3. <u>Cheating/Plagiarism</u>: Cheating or plagiarism of any kind is prohibited, and any student found cheating/ plagiarizing will be subject to disciplinary action and will receive a zero on the assignment/project/assessment. Student work is submitted to Turnitin.com to verify originality. District Governing Board Policy will be followed for the violation of this infraction.
- **Program Specifications:** Summer School courses are taught at a more accelerated pace than the regular school year. With IEPs and 504 plans, universal accommodations may apply during Summer School; however, not all accommodations and modifications on specific student plans may be applicable.
- 5. <u>Laptop Procedures</u>: Students need to follow campus instructions on turning in their laptop if taking a Summer School course. Students need to return their laptops to their home campus when they complete their course so that they can be reimaged and updated prior to classes starting in August.
- 6. Attendance Procedures: Students who choose to take their course in person are required to attend class on their campus every day of Summer School until they complete their class(es) or until the final day of the session (June 29th). If a student is late to school or leaves early, it will be recorded as a half (0.5) day absence. Students will be withdrawn from their in-person Summer School class(es) if they miss 3 days of school. Students will be able to continue working on their class(es) from home for the remainder of Summer School. Students who choose to take their course online need to login and complete work at least 4 days per week. If a student has not logged in within a 7 day period, the student will be withdrawn from summer school.
